It cheers my heart to hear from you and I hope you will write to me whenever you can, even if I am a long time in sending you an answer.

I am not surprised about Mr Williamson and Sister Gertrude. I think they should love the Lord and then they will be very happy together. You ought to explain to Sister G. that now she can lead Mr W. in the right way, if she will only be the Lord's herself. Do be plain with her and quite faithful. I would like to see her myself. But I fear I cannot come at present. I am needed here very much.

The work of the Lord is growing. Every day we are sending the Army farther and preaching Jesus in new places. I think many are praying for us, you are, and the Lord is answering your prayers. I have been in Wales 4 days this week, having meetings all day long and we had wonderful times. I saw Mr and Mrs Billups and stayed one night in their house. Mrs B is not very well, but the Lord is good.

In one of our letters you asked me about a medicine for your brother. I wrote to New York about it. Did they send you any papers? I could not get any information in London on the subject. I told you about in one of my letters, but I suppose it was lost.

I was glad to hear you had been to some of Dr Boardman's meetings. I hope you got blessed. He is a good man, and I trust has been the means of doing much good in Sweden.

The Lord is with you. In you. Round you. He cannot leave or forget you. He loves you. Loves to bless you and keep you. You live to love Him and you on Him and trust Him. Hallelujah. It is His will you should trust Him. And it is your will to trust Him. It is His that you should follow Him and it is yours to follow Him fully, all the way. Good. Good. Glory be to Jesus! He is leading you. Keep fast hold. Don't look behind. Don't falter or faint or think you will be overthrown.

Lay all again and again at the feet of Jesus. He likes it. You cannot do it too often or too well. He gave Himself for you. He gives Himself to you. That is the best. The best of all. He is all. And He is yours. Yours. Yours. Hallelujah.
