My dear friend,

Your letter of Nov 2 is to hand, I am always glad to hear from and of you, and of the Lord's work in your country.

I am much interested in the account you give me of the young man and young woman you refer to. I enclose a list of questions to be answered about each and when I hear again from you I will write more fully. We have a Home for young men, and another for young women, both for training them to do the work and I think if the way is open and you can recommend these two we will have them.

You should explain to them that they must be willing to leave all to follow Jesus, really. It is no good unless they do. Their whole heart and life must be given up as a living Sacrifice, just as Jesus gave up His life for us. – We are anxious about your country, it is often in our thoughts especially because it will be I expect the next after France. You must keep believing.

I am so glad you like the War Cry. We now print one hundred thousand every week. I have quite forgotten which sermons it is you asked for. I am so sorry. Please tell me again and I will send them at once. The Lord will take care of Sister Clara. I still have hope of her sister. The good seed will spring up and grow. Give my love to them both in the Lord. I have hope about them being used for the Lord's glory in the saving of many through grace.

I quite understand what you mean about the good people who make mistakes over the doctrine. Oh Lord let Thy light shine. Thou art light. You must walk in the light. Keep in the blood. Do not look behind. Never mind about yesterday – do not weep over yesterday, nor fear for tomorrow, but live and trust just now. Nu. This one moment for its own self. That is faith. That is living by faith. That is happiness and peace. God bless you. He will. He does. Tell the preachers you see about Holiness. Ask them if the precious blood cleanseth from all sin. Do not let them put it off – but just answer "yes" or "no".

I saw Mrs Billups a fortnight ago, and expect to be in Cardiff again tomorrow night – we have an all night meeting there. I hope Mrs B will be there all night. I wish you could be you would enjoy it much.

Some of our people have commenced work in Australia! They are getting many souls saved. We shall have to send out an officer, perhaps several, I expect. Pray about this please.

I will write again very soon upon hearing your answer to this.
