Mrs Booth is away at Dorquay – I will ask her about help in the house. I am sorry you have not a fellow worker – a Swede but perhaps it would not be good for you yet. The Lord wishes you to get strong and have <u>your</u> <u>own way</u>, then He will give you one. Trust Him. Do only what you can. Do not kill yourself. You must live for the sake of Sweden.

I am better than I was. I have good help in my office now, and much work I can leave.

Pray for us all. We have need of patience and wisdom. So of the Holy Ghost.
