My dear Sister in Jesus.

But I think of you and pray for all my Swedish friends and wonder when the Lord will open the way for me to see you again in the flesh that we may praise Him together. This week we are bringing from Malmö a young woman, the sister of one of our officers here, that she may be trained in England for work in her own country and I look upon this as the most important step we have yet taken with regard to Sweden. I think it is very likely that women full of the Holy Ghost would have much power in your country – they would be looked up to like angels and I am full of hope that we may be able to send some very soon! Of course many would be much surprised and some angry, but that would not matter if the Lord worked and souls were won for Jesus our Saviour.

How do you get on with the speaking? Do you speak for Jesus more than you did? “Open your mouth wide and I will fill it”.

I am filled with joy today in thinking of our High Priest – who is touched with the feeling of our infirmities. Who is in deep sympathy with all our troubles and tears and cares and who understands us and understand how to help us. To Him be glory. Remember this when Satan seeks to upset you your confidence and when the way is rough and you cannot see where it leads to – remember that the High Priest of your Salvation is gone before and that He is able to save to the uttermost because He ever liveth to make intercession for you. It is a favourite plan of the Devils to get us to think of Jesus dying for all, praying for all, loving all, and forgetting that it includes us, me. Watch against that. Think of and trust in Him as yours.
